



Rising Star Award

The Rising Star Award is intended to recognize an emerging leader in the field of Human Resources whose record reflects ongoing and exceptional growth. The nominee should be an individual whose performance demonstrates innovation, professionalism, and leadership.

Criteria for nomination is:

- seven years or less experience in the Human Resources field,
- a demonstrated and consistently high level of professional achievement,
- strong leadership qualities, and
- a strong commitment to the advancement of the Human Resources profession.

The recipient of the Rising Star Award will be announced, and all finalists will be recognized at the 2023 Southern New Mexico SHRM Employment Law Update on September 22, 2023. Finalists and winner will also be recognized on the Southern New Mexico SHRM website.

The recipient of the Rising Star Award will receive:

- an award recognizing the individual as the 2023 recipient,
- acknowledgement and photograph on Southern New Mexico SHRM's social media (if approved by winner), and
- a free registration for the 2024 Southern New Mexico SHRM Employment Law Update.

It is the responsibility of the nominator to complete the nomination form and provide a letter of support addressing the nominee's achievements, growth in the profession, leadership qualities, professional accomplishments, and strong commitment to the advancement of the Human Resources profession in sufficient detail to document why this individual should be considered as the 2023 Southern New Mexico SHRM "Rising Star" recipient.
